Milk Punch

Milk punch is a milk-based brandy or bourbon beverage. It consists of milk, the spirit, sugar, and vanilla extract. It is served cold and usually has nutmeg sprinkled on top. Milk punch may be clarified through the addition of ingredients which cause the milk to curdle, so that the solids contributing to the beverage's opacity may be strained out.

Hojicha: a Japanese green tea. It is distinctive from other Japanese green teas because it is roasted in a porcelain pot over charcoal, whereas most Japanese teas are steamed.

On the topic of Absinthe

Some bartenders and journalists will tell you about "the ban" on absinthe was lifted only recently. they might even pinpoint 2007 and National Absinthe Day, This was only a ploy by savvy absinthe company "lucid". Absinthe was indeed banned in the US in 1912, Italy 1913, France 1915, Germany 1923. The thing is- probably sometime in the 1960's according to absintheur Gwydion Stone, absinthe's ban fell through the cracks in a bit of bureaucratic reorganization. Absinthe has been perfectly legal for more than 40 years, but until the 2000's nobody thought to challenge conventional wisdom that dictated it wasn't.

First accurately described in a 1919 article in the New York Evening Telegram, this Cuban mixture of "bacardi, granatin, and French vermouth" was apparently christened in honor of Mario García Menocal, president of that country from 1913 to 1921. Before long, the Presidente was one of the most popular drinks in the U.S. as well, whether served illegally during Prohibition or legally after. Basil Woon, the wonderfully named society correspondent, deemed it the "aristocrat of cocktails," and there were many who were of his opinion.

This is a waste of time, a waste of liquor, and a waste of gentleman.

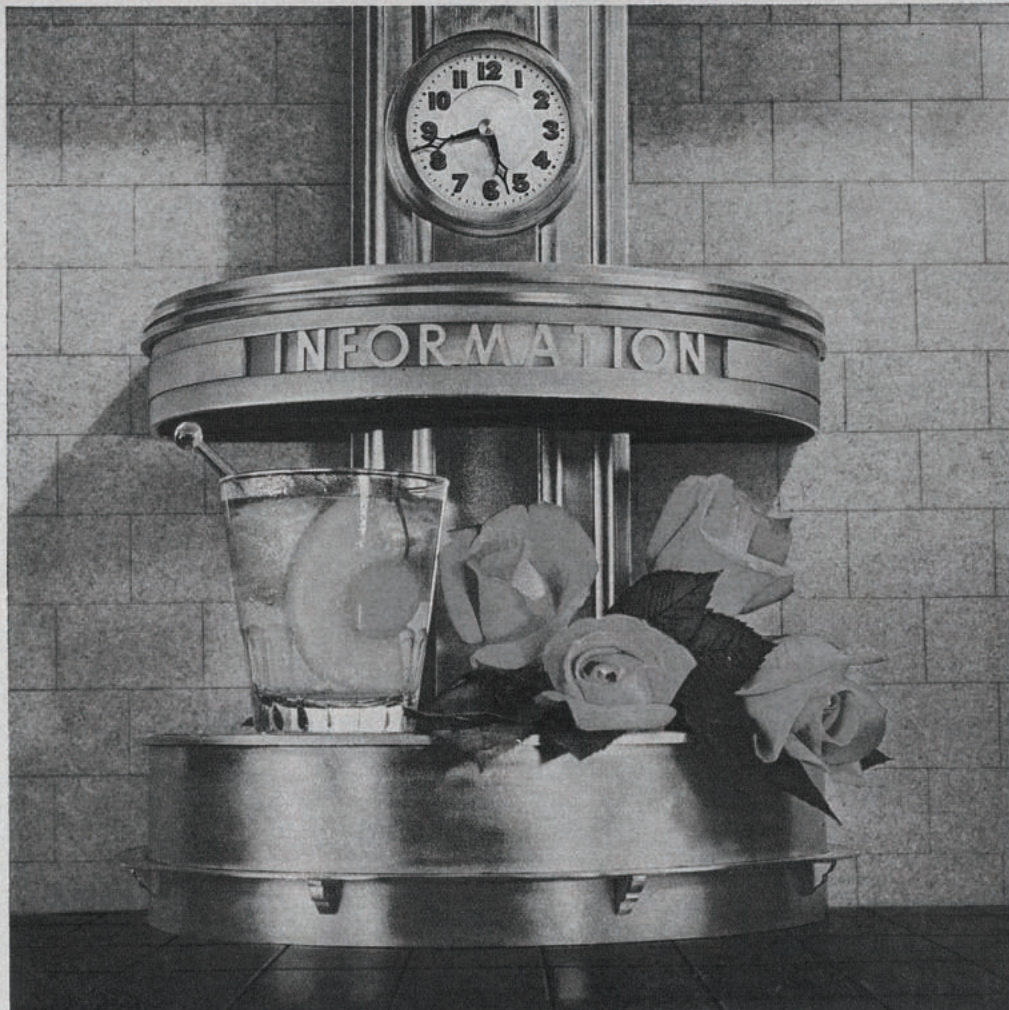
