Hanoi

Hanoi (Vietnamese: Hà Nội), estimated population nearly 6.5 million, is the capital and second-largest city of Vietnam. From 1010 until 1802, it was the most important political centre of Vietnam. It was eclipsed by Hue during the Nguyen Dynasty as the capital of Vietnam, but Hanoi served as the capital of French Indochina from 1902 to 1954. From 1954 to 1976, it was the capital of North Vietnam.

The city is located in central Vietnam on the banks of the Song Huong (Perfume River), just a few miles inland from the Bien Dong. It is about 700 km (438 mi.) south of the national capital of Hanoi and about 1100 km (690 mi.) north of Ho Chi Minh City, the country's largest city, formerly known as Saigon.

Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon) is the largest city in Vietnam. It was once known as Prey Nokor, an important Khmer seaport prior to annexation by the Vietnamese in the 17th century.

Under the name Saigon, it was the capital of the French colony of Cochinchina and later of the independent state of South Vietnam from 1954 to 1975. In 1976, Saigon merged with the surrounding province of Gia Dinh and was officially renamed Ho Chi Minh City.

The city center is situated on the banks of the Saigon River, 60 kilometers (37 mi) from the South China Sea and 1,760 kilometers (1,094 mi) south of Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam.

Nha Trang

Nha Trang city has a metropolitan area of 251 km² and population of about 500,000 (as of 2007 [update]). It borders Ninh Hoa town by the north, Cam Ranh city by the south, Diên Khánh town by the west and the South China Sea to the east. The city is located on the beautiful Nha Trang Bay, which was chosen by Travel and Leisure in two succeeding years as one of 29 most beautiful bays in the world. Nha Trang is surrounded on all three sides by mountains and a large island on the fourth side (in the ocean directly in front of the city's main area), blocking major storms from potentially damaging the city.

Vung Tau

Vung Tau

To most tourists, however, Vung Tau is more interesting for its extensive beaches. Tourists often prefer swimming at Back Beach (Bai Sau) but sightseeing in Front Beach (Bai Truc). Back Beach is well-known for its over 10 km of fine sand. As Vung Tau is only 130 km away from Ho Chi Minh City, it is a favourite resort destination for those wishing to get away from the city. In recent times, the number of foreign tourists visiting Vung Tau's beaches increased. [citation needed]. Vung Tau also allows access to nearby less visited beaches like Long Hai, Ho Tram and Ho Coc.
