TRADEWIND AIRPORT ESTABLISHED 1946

Shelby Masterson Kritser opened Tradewind Airport in Amarillo, Texas in 1946. He was an extremely talented pilot and excelled in aerobatics in his vintage World War II Grumman F8F Bearcat and Bücker Jungman. His goal was to bring people together through aviation.
